

TerHaar's Best Practices for the DBQ in APUSH

Instructions for the Reading the Question (15 mins):

- *Read the darn question (RTDQ)*
- *Identify the type of question*
- *Take two minutes to write down everything that comes to mind*
- *Read over and APARTS the documents (author, place and time, prior knowledge, audience, reason, the main idea, significance)*
- *Formulate thesis (one-sided, middle, or both)*

A Solid Introduction:

- *Provides a context or background information*
- *Addresses all aspects of the question*
- *States a clear position or thesis (underline)*
- *Provides an organizational framework or roadmap (allows for development of ideas)*
- *Demonstrates critical thinking (analysis, synthesis, evaluation)*
- *Uses the 2-1-1 format*

A Solid Essay:

- *Contains analysis, synthesis, and/or evaluation*
- *Assumes the reader is an idiot (explains everything)*
- *Includes a reference to 5-6 doc's (in any order)*
- *Provides a counter-argument*
- *Writes in the third person*
- *Properly cites doc's*
- *Avoids over-generalizations "Always" and "Never"*
- *Is at least three pages*
- *Contains a conclusion*

Analysis (detailed examination)- Categorize, compare, criticize, distinguish, examine

Evaluation (judgment)- Appraise, assess, choose, defend, estimate, predict

Synthesis (putting together parts to make a whole)- Compose, develop, formulate, organize, plan, propose
