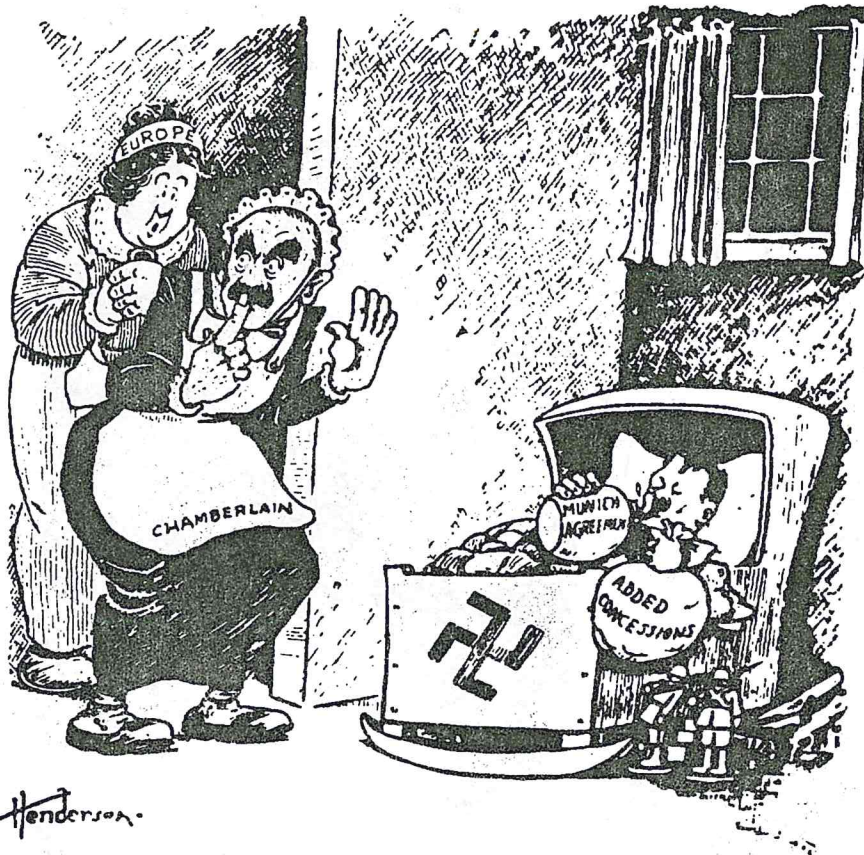


### THE MUNICH AGREEMENT
