What is the Final Solution? Why does Hitler begin to implement this? (Might be tough to find a specific source to answer second question, you may have to infer and come up with your own reasoning.)

What is the name of the secret police force created by the chief of the SS? What kind of society does this create, having so many different police forces?

What date signifies the beginning of the Nuremberg laws? Why are these such a big deal?

What happened during Kristallnacht? What were some of the fears that resulted from this event?

Describe a Jewish ghetto.

Compare and contrast Auschwitz and Dachau, how were they similar and how were they different?

What were conditions like for prisoners in the concentration camps?

Put yourself in the shoes of the soldiers, what would it have been like liberating one of these camps? Especially, if you had little idea of what was going on prior to seeing it.
